# JOB DESCRIPTION

Our Pioneer Family Worker will serve as a bridge between the church, families, and the school community, supporting the spiritual and emotional, needs of families and children. This role will focus on providing pastoral care, spiritual guidance, and community engagement, both within the church family and through building relationships on the school campus and the wider community.

You will be passionate about family ministry, youth development, and building meaningful relationships in the local community. We are looking for someone who can make a step change in this vital area of ministry

#### MAIN RESPONSBILITIES

- To lead and be the focal point for our church's ministry to children, young people and families in Wendover and Halton.
- Encourage and nurture discipleship among children and families, creating opportunities for spiritual growth, Bible engagement, and living out faith in daily life.
- To continue to deepen and enrich our relationships with schools, pre-schools,
   Wendover Youth Centre and uniformed groups.
- To develop and lead a programme of pastoral work, in partnership with our schools, to support the families who are most in need in our parish.
- To lead a programme of school chaplaincy, supported by volunteers from our church community.
- Working with the St Mary's ministry team as well as church volunteers, to continue to
  develop church-based activities that will help to bridge the gap between schools and other
  community organisations and our church. Develop and lead family programs: such as
  parenting courses, family worship, and outreach events.
- To work in partnership with Wendover Youth Centre engaging young people and encouraging them towards youthwork activities.

### PERSON SPECIFICATION

We are looking for a person with a strong commitment to the Christian faith and values who can:

- Sensitively proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom to children, young people and their families.
- Build trusting and lasting relationships, nurturing faith.
- Develop and oversee relationships with volunteers and staff, in the community, and with support services.
- Coordinate family-oriented events.
- Create a welcoming and inclusive environment for families, children and youth within our Church community.
- Foster a culture of teamwork and collaboration among volunteers.
- Effectively communicate with children and young people and families through various channels, including newsletter, social media and announcements.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to build relationships with individuals of all ages.
- Although not vital it would be an advantaged to have experience working with families, children or youth in a ministry or educational setting.

#### What we can offer

- 3 year fixed-term contract
- A salary between £32k-34k pa, depending on experience
